5. Red Cross Personalized Care, the View From the Front Lines

We all know that the American Red Cross provides shelter, feeding, and mass care during and after disasters and other large and small emergencies. It also provides individualized help, through Family Services volunteers, for those affected. Such assistance can extend for many months, sometimes years, after the disaster is "over." Red Cross Family Services and Mass Care supervisor Sue Hammarlund, a Valley Disaster Preparedness Team member, trained CERT 2 responder, and a Red Cross volunteer since 1993, has responded to over 50 local and national disasters for the Red Cross providing individual and family assistance, from mass care at the Pentagon after 911, to hurricanes Katrina and Hortensia, the Northridge earthquake, and recent wildfires in Washington state. Hear her perspective, and learn how the delivery of mass care has changed over time.
