Agnes Lewis, PLUM Co-Chair spoke about the Second Dwelling Unit, a city planning proposal to repeal the old LA ordinance in order to comply with State law. It has approved by the City Planning Commission and is being considered by the City Council's PLUM committee. She also gave brief heads-up about the hearings on a Home Sharing Ordinance (nicknamed the AirBnB ordinance). This proposes to register properties so they pay an occupancy tax when rented short term, and allows people to rent only their primary residence for a maximum of 90 days a year. This is leading to a lot of controversy.
