The minutes for the October 15, 2007 were approved with correction of the spelling of Las Lomas.

## **New Business:**

Hillcrest Christian School: change to the existing Conditional Use Permit:

Parent, Mark Campbell and Representative, Michael Himenas from Hillcrest Christian School gave a presentation on the changes to Hillcrest's Conditional Use Permit (CUP).

The school is trying to find a new location for the high school and if they find a large enough site then they may move the entire school.

Modification of operating hours and hours for special events, a extension of five years of the current enrollment limit for junior and senior high school students.

Their current CUP allows them to operate from 7:00AM to 7:00PM M-F and they want to change this to 6:30AM to 8:30PM M-F.

Currently the weekend use is limited to indoor activities and they want to change this to indoor and outdoor activities.

Currently they are allowed three events from 3:00PM to 8:30PM M-F and they want to change this to twenty-five events from 3:00PM to 10:00PM M-F.

They currently have a cap of 120 for enrollment of junior and senior high school students, this will expire this fall. They want to extend this 120 cap to 2012.

ENV-2007-5000-CE: ZA-2003-6323: 16151 ½ Rinaldi Street: Installation of twelve panel antennas mounted inside faux boulders.

The information that was provided by the city does not portray the original site on DWP property. We need to check into this further.
