In January 2025, at the time the fires raged and destroyed property in the San Fernando Valley, excessively high winds also caused property damage to San Fernando Valley properties. During that time frame, the Museum was hit hard by winds that destroyed numerous of the Museum's outside exhibits including its Walk of Story prints, damaged 100 year-old Knapp statues, and damaged our recently installed Historic Timeline of the San Fernando Valley panels. Upon recent examination, we realized that all four 4' x 6' timeline panels need to be reprinted and re-installed. With regard to the Walk of Stories exhibit, the Museum will not only reprint the photos but wishes to install plexiglass or some other protection over them to protect them from future environmental winds.

The Museum's mission is to support all that is San Fernando Valley history. We are free to the public, and all-volunteer staff and exist to educate our patrons, members and the general public about the history of the San Fernando Valley through historical honesty. But most significantly, we partner with various Valley underserved communities to encourage them to incorporate their histories and stories into the Museum's more inclusive timeline of the History of the SFV. Understanding the cultural pride of any group creates connections and generates strong communities.
